

Do I need a library card?

You must have a library card in your name each time you check out at an SCLS library, including the bookmobile.

When are my items due?

All materials are checked out for three weeks. Automatic renewals apply to qualifying material.

Where can I return my items?

Material can be returned at any SCLS branch, including the Bookmobile or RiverShare library.

What happens if my items are overdue?

Scott County Library System is fine-free, which means that you will not accrue fines on most overdue material.

However, if an item is more than 30 days overdue or has been damaged beyond repair, a bill may be charged to your account. When an account has accrued more than \$5, we are no longer able to check material out.

When the overdue material is returned, all bills are waived and you can check out again!

Where did my stop go?

If a stop doesn't have enough regular visitors, we have to move on to a more popular stop!

However: schedules change based on the season with summer allowing for more neighborhood stops and winter calling for less rural driving due to extreme weather.
